In order to do this, we are offering three bursary awards to RMMHA members who qualify based on the below selection criteria. We believe in the holistic development of our players, this bursary is designed to celebrate not only their achievements on the ice but also their dedication to academic excellence and personal growth.

Selection Criteria

To be eligible for this award, the candidate must:

- Be a current member of the RMMHA in good standing as defined by the constitution of the RMMHA*
- Have been a member of the RMMHA in 'good standing' for a minimum of 5 years
- Be attending a post-secondary institution or apprenticeship program in the upcoming year
- Have maintained a high standard of academic excellence (minimum 65% average)
- Be active as a mentor to others both in school and on the ice

Award

- Name of award: Richmond Munster Minor Hockey Association Bursary
- Amount of award: Three (3) Awards of up to \$500 each. One award to be provided to a graduate from South Carleton High School, one to a graduate from Sacred Heart Catholic High School as well as one to a graduate to other High Schools in our area.

Selection Process

How to apply

Applicants must submit a **one-page essay** outlining why they feel they should be selected as this year's award recipient. This essay should make note of such things as how have they demonstrated leadership and academic excellence, how they have contributed to their community (school, hockey, etc.), and make mention of their goals in pursuing a post-secondary or apprenticeship program in the upcoming year. The applicants must identify which High School they attend for award presentation coordination, if selected for the award.

Applications must be submitted by email to the RMMHA at sec.rmmha@gmail.com no later than **Friday April 26, 2024**.

Recipient selection

Applications will be forwarded to the RMMHA for review. The board of directors for the RMMHA will select one or more recipients for this award.

Presentation of Award

A cheque for up to \$500 will be presented directly to the recipient(s). The winner(s) will be notified and then will be announced at in coordination with their High School.
